

ENROLMENT AND RULES

Applications must be sent by **7 september 2021** (date as registered by our server) by email to the following address: **clementcompetition2020@gmail.com**

The following documents are required:

1. Completed and signed application form;
2. Candidates should clearly state on the application form the names of music teachers with whom they are studying, or have studied, on a continuous basis, either publically or privately;
3. Copy of a valid identity card or passport;
4. Certificates of study;
5. Short curriculum vitae
6. A recent photo, exempt from copyright, to be used in competition publications. The photo should be minimum 600 dpi, measuring 12cm.

This is non-refundable if a candidate withdraws his/her application. **The Competitors who have attended the two masterclasses at the APM Scuola di Alto Perfezionamento Musicale in Saluzzo are exempt from paying the applications fee.**

Signed consent for personal data processing and acceptance of competition rules.

By applying to the competition candidates agree to comply with these competition rules. Any breach of the rules will result in disqualification from the competition. In the event of any claims or objections, the original rules in Italian will be held as legally binding.

AUDITIONS

1. All auditions will be public and will be recorded in audio and video formats.

Any recording or filming carried out by public and/or private, Italian and/or foreign stations is implicitly accepted by all applicants to the competition.

2. The competition Secretary will inform candidates regarding the date and time at which they should present themselves. A valid form of identification will be required.

Candidates will perform in alphabetical order, starting from the letter chosen at random during the preliminary meeting of the Jury.

3. Candidates must reside in Saluzzo for the period in which they are competing. Address and telephone number should be given to the Secretary.

4. An adequate timings schedule will be made available to candidates for study purposes at the APM - Scuola di Alto Perfezionamento Musicale

JURY

Any member of the Jury having been a teacher to, or being a family member of a candidate must abstain from voting.

It is prohibited for candidates to contact members of the Jury during the competition.
